Project Description: This project will provide funds to complete the design/engineering and construction of the traffic signal and ancillary improvements (US 60 road diet restriping and N./S. Main Street intersection improvements) at the Newman’s Branch Road Intersection. A planning study was completed in FY 2024 which verified the need to improve the intersection to mitigate congestion and to accommodate for safety for vehicles, pedestrians, and bicyclists. The project is Air Quality Exempt based on 40 CFR 93.126.
