- **CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS**

Paul Davis called the meeting to order and requested self-introductions from those in attendance.

- **INTRODUCTION OF MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING AS DISTRIBUTED**

No action required, action taken in joint meeting December 6, 2018

- **KYOVA TRANSPORTATION STUDIES UPDATE**

- **LAWRENCE COUNTY US 52 INTERCHANGE FEASIBILITY STUDY** - Steve Bergman with MSG gave an update on the project. It is moving forward and several alternatives have been developed.
- **WAL-MART WAY “GREEN T” INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS** - Funding has been approved to add a continuous lane and left turning lane to US 52 at Walmart Way.
- **CHARLEY CREEK INTERSECTION SAFETY** - The study is in progress. Several alternatives have been developed and are currently being refined.
- **SANDUSKY ROAD STUDY** – A public meeting was held in January. Feedback from the meeting is being addressed as part of the study.
- **CR 1/CR 15 ECAT** -
- **OHIO RIVER BRIDGE CROSSING STUDY (2-YEAR)** – The project, which is in the beginning stages will look at the feasibility of adding a bridge to connect WV 193 with OH SR 7.
- **SAFETY STUDY FOR CABELL AND WAYNE COUNTIES (2-YEAR)** – The study which is in the beginning stages will look at safety in Cabell and Wayne counties and provide recommendations for safety improvements.
- **5TH STREET WEST BRIDGE STUDY** – AECOM is gathering data related to the bridge to complete an overall assessment to determine recommendations for improvement or replacement
- **ARLINGTON PARK MOBILITY STUDY** – GAI has conducted stakeholder meetings and a public meeting. Input from the public meeting has been very valuable. The study will determine improvements that can be made to enhance accessibility in the Arlington Park neighborhood
- **CITY OF HUNTINGTON PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROGRAM** – Kimley-Horn has had discussions with WVDOH on their Pavement Management Program and has assessed the condition of roadways.
- **MARSHALL UNIVERSITY BIKE PLAN** – Edward Tucker Architects is planning to meet with additional stakeholders soon to continue getting feedback on planned bike routes.
- **MILTON TRAFFIC MOBILITY STUDY** – Carpenter Marty Transportation is in the process of assessing data to complete the mobility study for Milton

- **AMENDMENT #8 TO THE KYOVA 2040 INTEGRATED MTP AND 2018-2021 TIP**

Saleem Salameh described the projects to be amended in the 2018-2021 TIP. These projects include two projects in West Virginia and the addition of a corridor management plan for US 52 in Ohio. The amendment also includes transit projects.

Jennifer Woodall made the motion and Patrick Leighty seconded the motion to move Amendment #8 to the KYOVA 2018-2021 TIP forward for Policy Committee approval. It was approved unanimously.

- **PRESENTATION OF THE KYOVA DRAFT FY 2020 UPWP**

Saleem Salameh explained that the UPWP describes the activities of KYOVA staff for FY 2020. There are several studies that have been added to this year’s UPWP. This year KYOVA

will also be focusing on Performance Targets as directed by the FAST Act. This the first draft. The final will be completed for the April meeting.

Kelly Ward made the motion and Bill Dingus seconded the motion to move the KYOVA FY 2020 UPWP forward for Policy Committee approval. It was approved unanimously.

- **2019 COORDINATED PUBLIC TRANSIT-HUMAN SERVICES TRANSPORTATION PLAN**

Laura Brown with RLS gave an update on the plan. The Coordinated Plan will assist in coordinating transportation providers and human service agencies with transportation needs. Anyone who wishes to apply for 5310 funds must also be included in the plan.

- **PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION AGENCY SAFETY PLAN**

Terri Sicking gave an update. All transit agencies will be included in the states' safety plans.

- **TRANSIT SYSTEMS STATUS UPDATE FOR THE HUNTINGTON, WV-KY-OH URBANIZED AREA**

- **TTA** – Almost all bike racks near bus stops are installed. Should finish in the next 2 weeks. Restrooms at the TTA Center have been renovated. Transit ridership is increasing partly due to the agreement with Marshall University.
- **LAWRENCE COUNTY TRANSIT** – Receiving new demand response vehicles today
- **ASHLAND BUS SYSTEM** – Approval letter to purchase 2 cutaways from state contract.

- **FTA 5310 TRANSIT PROGRAM FOR THE HUNTINGTON, WV-KY-OH URBANIZED AREA**

Round 4 applications were delayed due to the government shutdown. Applications have now been submitted. Awaiting approval from FTA. Round 5 applications will be released soon. RLS has been hired to assist KYOVA in streamlining the application. A part-time employee will also be hired to assist with the program.

- **TRANSPORTATION PERFORMANCE MANAGEMENT COORDINATION UPDATE**

KYOVA has been tracking performance measures & targets and provided a summary to the TAC.

- **KYOVA STUDIES/BRIEF PROJECT UPDATES/INFORMATIONAL SESSION**

- **FEDERAL UPDATE** – Next deadline is May 20, 2019. All PM2 & PM3 information will need to be included in the TIP/MTP. OH/KYOVA MOU has information outlined for what needs to be included in the document.
- **TRI-STATE AIRPORT PROJECTS** – No Update.
- **CITY OF HUNTINGTON PROJECTS** – Hal Greer Blvd Public Meeting – held in January. Stantec is looking at intersection changes and medians. The next meeting will be March 21st. The city is also moving forward requesting funding for lighting along the corridor. A

question was asked concerning standing water on the roadways in Huntington. The Stormwater Utility should be addressed.

- **WVDOT/STIP UPDATE** – In the process of developing the new STIP. Public outreach as part of the update will be conducted in Huntington on April 4th from 4-7pm. Culloden Interchange has slowed due to Environmental Justice. I-64 section between Merritt's Creek to Huntington Mall will be upgraded next. It is scheduled to be let May 14th. US 52 in Wayne County has encountered some issues.
- **KYTC CENTRAL OFFICE** – KYTC is working on 2020 safety targets. Transportation Asset Management Plan is recently completed. Work is beginning on the 6-year highway plan using the SHIFT process.
- **BOYD AND GREENUP COUNTIES PROJECTS UPDATE** – The handout included shows updates to projects in Boyd and Greenup counties.
- **LAWRENCE COUNTY PROJECTS UPDATE** – Patrick Leighty gave an update on projects in Lawrence County.
- **ODOT UPDATE** – Scott Thompson gave an update on ODOT projects in Lawrence County. US 52 will be resurfaced soon.
- **2019 BUILD GRANTS** – KYOVA applied for a BUILD grant for the Culloden Interchange

- **KYOVA SUBALLOCATED FUNDS (STP,TAP,CMAQ-OH) UPDATE**

Projects have been submitted by several agencies for this round of funding. Funding may be more competitive in the future as more agencies apply. Projects will have to meet Policy Board approval and then sent forward to each state for processing.
