- Do not use "see attached" as an answer to any question in the application. If you require more space please continue on an attached separate 8 ½ x 11-inch sheet of paper with the Heading and Section Name/Question at the top of each page.

A 20% match is required for all STBG TA set-aside projects. A Resolution and/or signed letter of commitment from the signature authority (Judge/Executive, Mayor, etc.) committing the match for this project must be included. Please keep in mind there is extensive documentation required when using in-kind match and the project sponsor will be required to provide this as part of the reimbursement process. If cash will be used for match, the letter should indicate that the Local Public Agency (LPA) has the funds available to use as soon as the project is approved to commence.
