

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING USE OF OHIO CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE AND RELIEF SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION ACT (CRRSAA) FUNDS FROM THE LAWRENCE COUNTY URBANIZED AREA TO THE KYOVA INTERSTATE PLANNING COMMISSION FOR FY 2022 UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM WORK ELEMENT 381622: LAWRENCE COUNTY, OHIO MTP UPDATE (PID#115335)

- WHEREAS,** KYOVA Interstate Planning Commission serves as the planning organization for the Huntington, WV-KY-OH Transportation Management Area (TMA); and
- WHEREAS,** the planning area of the Huntington, WV-KY-OH TMA includes the West Virginia counties of Cabell, Wayne and a portion of Putnam, the Kentucky counties of Boyd and Greenup and the urbanized portion of Lawrence County, Ohio; and
- WHEREAS,** based on the 2010 Census, the counties named above were designated as the Huntington, WV-KY-OH TMA on July 18, 2012; and
- WHEREAS,** the FHWA administers and funds the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriation Act (CRRSAA) for the planning, construction and maintenance of eligible projects and activities; and
- WHEREAS,** a portion of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriation Act (CRRSAA) funds are suballocated directly to Transportation Management Areas (TMAs) – urbanized areas with over 200,000 population – to be programmed by the corresponding metropolitan planning organization for eligible projects and activities; and
- WHEREAS,** the KYOVA Interstate Planning Commission receives suballocated Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriation Act (CRRSAA) funds from the states of West Virginia, Kentucky, and Ohio for the Huntington, WV-KY-OH TMA to fund projects as approved by the KYOVA Policy Board; and
- WHEREAS,** the KYOVA Interstate Planning Commission updated the FY 2022 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) to include \$37,943 in suballocated Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriation Act (CRRSAA) funds from the USDOT for the Huntington, WV-KY-OH TMA to update the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP);
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Policy Committee of the KYOVA Interstate Planning Commission, at a regularly scheduled meeting on July 23, 2021, approves the KYOVA FY 2022 UPWP update to include use of \$37,943 (Lawrence County Urbanized Area) Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriation Act (CRRSAA) funds.
