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## **KYOVA Interstate Planning Commission Annual Listing of Federally Obligated Projects**

**(for the Kentucky counties of Boyd and Greenup)**

**Kentucky Contract Year/FY 2019: July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019**

**Federal Fiscal Year 2019: October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019**

The new transportation bill passed in 2012, Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century (MAP-21) outlines the requirement for Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) to publish an annual listing of obligated projects for which funds have been given in the preceding year, including a listing of pedestrian and bicycle projects.

*“An annual listing of projects, including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities, for which Federal funds have been obligated in the preceding year shall be published or otherwise made available by the cooperative effort of the State, transit operator, and metropolitan planning organization for public review. The listing shall be consistent with the categories identified in the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).” (23 U.S.C., Sec. 1201)*

This report is published in response to the above-mentioned criteria by listing all federally funded transportation projects in the MPOs urbanized area that were obtained during the State Fiscal Year (FY) from July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019 and the Federal Fiscal Year from October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019. The work obligated refers to the Federal government’s financial commitment to pay or reimburse the lead agency for the federal share of a project’s cost. Obligation in no way refers to the expenditure or project completion; but only that the specific project has been marked and approved for federal reimbursement.

The following report details projects that obligated federal funds in Boyd and Greenup Counties, Kentucky. This report documents federal funds obligated by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, local public agencies, and the Ashland Bus System.

The information provided is consistent with how projects are listed in the *KYOVA Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) FY 2018-2021*, i.e. projects are shown with a project identification number, route, section, location, and description of project and funding amounts. This list provides information concerning the amount of federal funds that were authorized during fiscal year 2019 and “other” funding amounts during fiscal year 2019 and previous funds authorized. Project funding obligation information for the Ashland Bus System (ABS) has been included in this report as provided by the Ashland Bus System, Ashland, Kentucky.

An obligation is the federal government’s legal commitment to pay the federal share of a project’s cost and one that has been authorized by a federal agency, such as the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) or the Federal Transit Administration (FTA). Obligated projects are not necessarily initiated or completed in the programmed year and the amount of the obligation may not necessarily equal the total cost of the project. For FTA projects, obligations occur when the FTA grant is awarded. For FHWA projects, obligations occur when a project agreement is executed and the state/grantee request that the funds be obligated.

The report's purpose, other than that of listing federally obligated transportation projects, is to provide an increased transparency of government spending on transportation projects and strategies to state and local officials and to the public. To realize this federal objective, a proactive approach to sharing information with the public in a user-friendly format has been provided in this report.

During FY 2019 the KYOVA Interstate Planning Commission, cooperatively with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) – Division of Planning and the Ashland Bus System developed the following list of projects that were obligated in the fiscal year 2019 for Boyd and Greenup counties, Kentucky.
